As with the original 'Ozynimbium' flag design and its other variants, variant 1B presents a centred sunburst that is based on the famous 'rising sun' slouch hat badge of the Australian Army, its sixteen major rays symbolising all of the states and territories of the full Australian Commonwealth. Centred within the sunburst is a green-fimbriated Commonwealth Star, which will visually resolve only in closer views. From a distance the sunburst may also suggest a golden wattle blossom. Departing from the original Ozynimbium design, variant 1B has a black field as well as a circular array of sixteen small representations of the Australian-style Southern Cross, suggesting the apparent circular rotation of Crux around the South Celestial Pole. In addition the design is bordered by a strikingly distinctive frame of small, coloured triangles, which borrows the basic red-blue-green-and-gold motif of the 'Opal Empire' flag design and its variants. Some of the many possible treatments for the remaining flags and ensigns of the nation are also depicted above.
