Centred in the hoist is a 'raised' gold Commonwealth Star on a green field, the seven points of the Star representing Australia's six states and its various territories. Surrounding the Star is a unique circular pattern of red-white-and-blue. Thus the design embraces all of Australia's national colours within a single distinctive medallion. In the fly, the Australian-style Southern Cross completes the design. Variants '1' and '3' of the design replace the green field with blue, and variants '2' and '3' add further symbolism with sixteen red-and-blue stripes in the fly, a first for any national flag and a virtual guarantee of instant recognisability.
